I hope you are all doing well even under this extremely crazy summer and find time to cherish your loved ones, as well as creating delightful paintings. Remember, July is the World Watercolor Month!

There are several items I would like to draw your attention to. Earlier we sent you an email explaining a major change in our upcoming 2024 Members' Exhibition & Small Works Exhibition. Because the atrium at the UNT Health Science Center will no longer be available for all future art exhibitions, we have to change the location and time of our scheduled Members' Show. New arrangements are as follows (An update prospectus will be sent to you soon):

Location: The REC at Grapevine (1175 Municipal Way, Grapevine, TX)

Exhibition Dates: Dec 7-21, 2024 Deadline for Submission: Nov 1, 2024

I hope these unexpected changes do not cause too much inconvenience to you.

Additionally, I am quite sure most of you have heard about the exciting news that Fabriano-In-Watercolor 2024 will be held in the Fort Worth Community Arts Center (1300 Gendy Street, Fort Worth) on October 14 -19, 2024. In collaboration with the Fabriano-In-Aquarello in Italy, this event in Fort Worth will showcase more than 1000 curated watercolor paintings by artists from more than 180 countries all over the world. The event will also feature demonstrations conducted by internationally well-known masters. It is definitely a great occasion to interact with watercolor artists near and afar.

To ensure its success and to allow us a chance to participate, the Exhibition Chair, Laurin McCracken, is asking for volunteers to assist in the many functions of the event. We have previously sent out an email asking for volunteers to serve as team leaders of different functions. I thank those of you who have responded. In the near future, additional requests for volunteer team members will be sent to you. I thank you in advance for your kind considerations.

Our next Monthly Meeting is on the third Monday of September (Sept 16th). The Demo Artist will be Scott Bodell. Scott was trained as a graphic designer and medical illustrator. He is currently an illustrator and assistant professor at the University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center in Dallas. I am very excited about the upcoming 3-day workshop in October 22nd–24th conducted by Lisa Tennant. She is truly an accomplished artist of botanicals and urban landscapes in photorealistic style. Her workshop is titled "Tangible Patterns, Painting Color, Light & Texture". Registration is open. Based on previous experience, seats go fast. 

Guest Demo Artist **Scott Bodell**



For Scott Bodell drawing and painting became a full blown passion at an early age. For years, he filled sketchbooks copying the bird art of Audubon and others. He developed enough skill to copy almost anything he could see.

After college as a graphic design major, medical illustration was a perfect combination for an ambitious and academic artist. Scott's Graduate studies at UT Southwestern Medical Center yielded a master's degree and started his career in Dallas as a medical illustrator.

Scott has discovered he has new stories to tell. His academic curiosity now reveals that same beautiful gesture and flow all around him. Fine art is a new avenue of exploration and expression. Light and shadow describe form, while that graceful gesture and flow tells stories that inspire him. Mountains and canyons are boldly defined by light and shadow. But within the bigger shapes, textures of rocks and brush tell the story of creation, time and geology. Trees are exactly analogous to his ongoing inspiration with bones.

For Scott, the most rewarding and satisfying revelation from two years revisiting nature through art has been the people, the engaging enthusiasm, and joy he shares through art, and the humility and support from those in our new community of fellow artists.



It also won first place earlier this year in Kentucky Watercolor Society's Regional "AquaVenture" in Lexington, Kentucky.








