Born in Beijing, China, Zheng Lu immigrated to the United States in 2009 to pursue a master's degree. Zheng knew his professional path would lie in the creative industry, and he is utilizing his artistic background to visualize design solutions with his skills.

Zheng Lu's love for watercolor painting's immediate, spontaneous, and effective way of capturing mood and atmosphere helps express his feelings while maintaining respect for his source of inspiration.

Lu focuses on painting local scenery, urban life and nature, emphasizing light and atmosphere. He uncovers the hidden beauty of our surroundings and convey stories about people and places in an artistic manner. Along with local landscapes, he also enjoys depicting classic European architecture, piazzas, and street life.

Lu has two main goals for painting. First, he utilizes his drawing skills to inspire more sketching within his profession. Second, he wants to teach watercolor workshops and share his tips and tricks. Like all of us, he struggled with watercolor early on, finding it to be a love-and-hate relationship. For him, watercolor should be a source of fun and joy if it works well.

He has had several paintings selected for state exhibits across the country and is one of the youngest signature members of the Southwestern Watercolor Society. Lu resides in Plano, Texas with his wife and daughter.


