




## **October Member Meeting**


















**Krystyna Dale**'s painting Kazoo won the Best of Show award at the Lake Granbury Art Association Fall Juried Show.






Les McDonald Jr.'s painting Dining Out, won 1st Place during the Watercolor Art Society-Houston Annual Members Exhibition.
